Annual Meeting provides homeowners amenities updates

On December 10th the FoxCreek Homeowners Association, Inc. held its 2nd Annual Membership Meeting. A total of 31 homes were represented at the meeting. A number of topics were discussed including the 2009 budget. A budget narrative was created and distributed to further clarify each budget item. The Cosby Titan Varsity Cheerleaders gave their school a lot to be proud of in 2008. They retained their title as Dominion District Champions for the second year in a row. The squad also earned their first Central Region Championship Title, by placing 1st among 16 Teams in the Central Region, which includes squads from the entire Richmond area. The Top 4 teams qualified to go to the State Championships held at the VCU Siegel Center and compete against the Top 16 Teams in Virginia. At the VHSL AAA State Championship on November 8, 2008, this talented group qualified for Finals, earning the privilege of being named State Qualifiers when they finished 5th in the State. It has been some time since a team from the Central Region made it to the Final Round at States and was cause for celebration. In addition to the ladies incredible athletic skills, 16 of the team's 22 team members earned All-Academic Honors, which were presented at the Dominion District Championships held at James River HS in late October. Three freshmen team members are straight-A students, but are not entitled to qualify for All-Academic honors. Coach Catharine Walters plans to return next year to guide the

tually as the community grows, amenities will be built on Foxfield side of Woolridge.

- There will be approximately 1,100 homes within sections 1 and 2 of Fox Creek. Section 1 will contain approximately 500 homes and Section 2 will contain roughly 600 homes. Phase II of FoxCreek will possibly begin in late 2010. At this time, it is anticipated to contain townhomes, condominiums and commercial property.
- The clubhouse currently being built is designed for roughly 500 to 600 homes. There is a home located on the other side of Woolridge which may later be used as an additional clubhouse for the community. This home is approximately 6,000 square feet and could house on-site management, if necessary.
- The Foxfield entrance design has been completed. Enhancements will begin in early January. There will be a sign similar in design to the FoxCreek signage but

it will not be identical. At this time, the widening of Woolridge Road has been placed on hold due to County budgetary and bonding issues.

- IT was estimated that the cut through to Cosby High School would not be constructed until 2010.
- GemCraft is a new home builder in the community. They are based out of Forestville Maryland and currently have 14 lots to build on.

Minutes for the meeting are being prepared and will be placed upon the website upon approval. Please be sure to visit the site often to stay abreast of new information. Thank you to all of you who attended the annual meeting. Thank you for your support during this transition in management! We look forward to meeting and speaking with each of you as the year moves forward. Happy 2009 from all of us at Stellar Community Management!
